A. Objectives of Hiring a Qualitative Study Consultant (Project Coordinator for Visayas)

The LCSFC needs a qualitative study specialist who will assist the USC-Office of the Population Studies Foundation, Inc. (OPS) in designing the follow-up study data collection and processing protocols, prepare the in-depth interview guides, oversee the translation of IDI guides and consent forms, conduct the data collection training in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, and oversee, along with the USC-Center for Social Research and Education (CSRE), data collection and data processing operations in the Visayas.

B. Desired Qualifications

- 1. Must have at least a master's degree in social sciences
- 2. Must have extensive experience conducting qualitative research (qualitative data collection and processing)
- 3. Must have extensive experience in training qualitative research data collection teams
- 4. Previous experience working with the OPS in conducting qualitative research is highly preferred

C. Scope of Work

The work covered by this consultancy includes:

- 1. Works with OPS in planning and implementing qualitative data collection operations, including preparations, translations, and finalization of in-depth interview guides
- 2. Assists OPS in training the qualitative field personnel in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao and ensures that all domain-hired personnel complete the required qualitative data collection training
- 3. Assists USC-CSRE in drafting the inception report and in recruiting and screening qualified field personnel for data collection
- 4. Assists USC-CSRE in the overall supervision and monitoring of data collection operations in the Visayas from initiation until completion
- 5. Conducts oversight of data processing activities (transcription, translation, coding)
- 6. Ensures that Visayas data collection personnel complete the debriefing sessions at the end of data collection
- 7. Participates in the dissemination of project information and results
- 8. Performs other tasks deemed necessary to achieve the study objectives
